This EPA-Approved refresher class is required annually for Asbestos Abatement Supervisors in order to maintain their training accreditation status. The class reviews topics introduced in the initial Supervisor Class as well as changes or revisions in laws and regulations. Key concepts are covered, often through the presentation and discussion of case studies. Course is taught by instructors that have years of actual field experience on abatement projects.

(NOTE: The 4-Hour Asbestos Inspector Refresher and the 4-Hour Asbestos Management Planner Refresher are scheduled back-to-back on the same day).

8-Hour EPA AHERA Asbestos Project Designer Refresher Class

The class is taught by accredited Project Designers having years of real-world abatement project design experience.
